Description

Teaching : Explication de textes : Kate Chopin, The Awakening

Objective : Kate Chopin's novel *The Awakening* was condemned by numerous critics at the time of its publication in 1899 for being scandalous, immoral, and unhealthy. In the 1960's the novel was rediscovered and hailed as a classic of American literature and especially of women's writing. In addition to focusing on close reading, this seminar will consider various theoretical interpretations, those that have contributed to the novel's re-evaluation. The main goal of the class, however, is learning the terms and tools of literary analysis of prose, including narration, style, tone, genre and focalization. Towards the end of the semester, in order to put Chopin's novel into context, we read a couple short stories by two other woman writers of the turn of the century.

Evaluation : Regular attendance, participation, and the reading requirement each week. The class will be evaluated by two in-class written assignments. Students will have a chance to revise the midterm in order to improve it. The first assignment will consist of a close analysis of a short passage and the final assignment will be on the whole book.

Bibliography : The book is already available at Bastal in Anthropole.
