To export some of the results obtained during your last search, select the publications to be exported by using the “**select all**” button (1) or by **checking each publication** concerned (2).

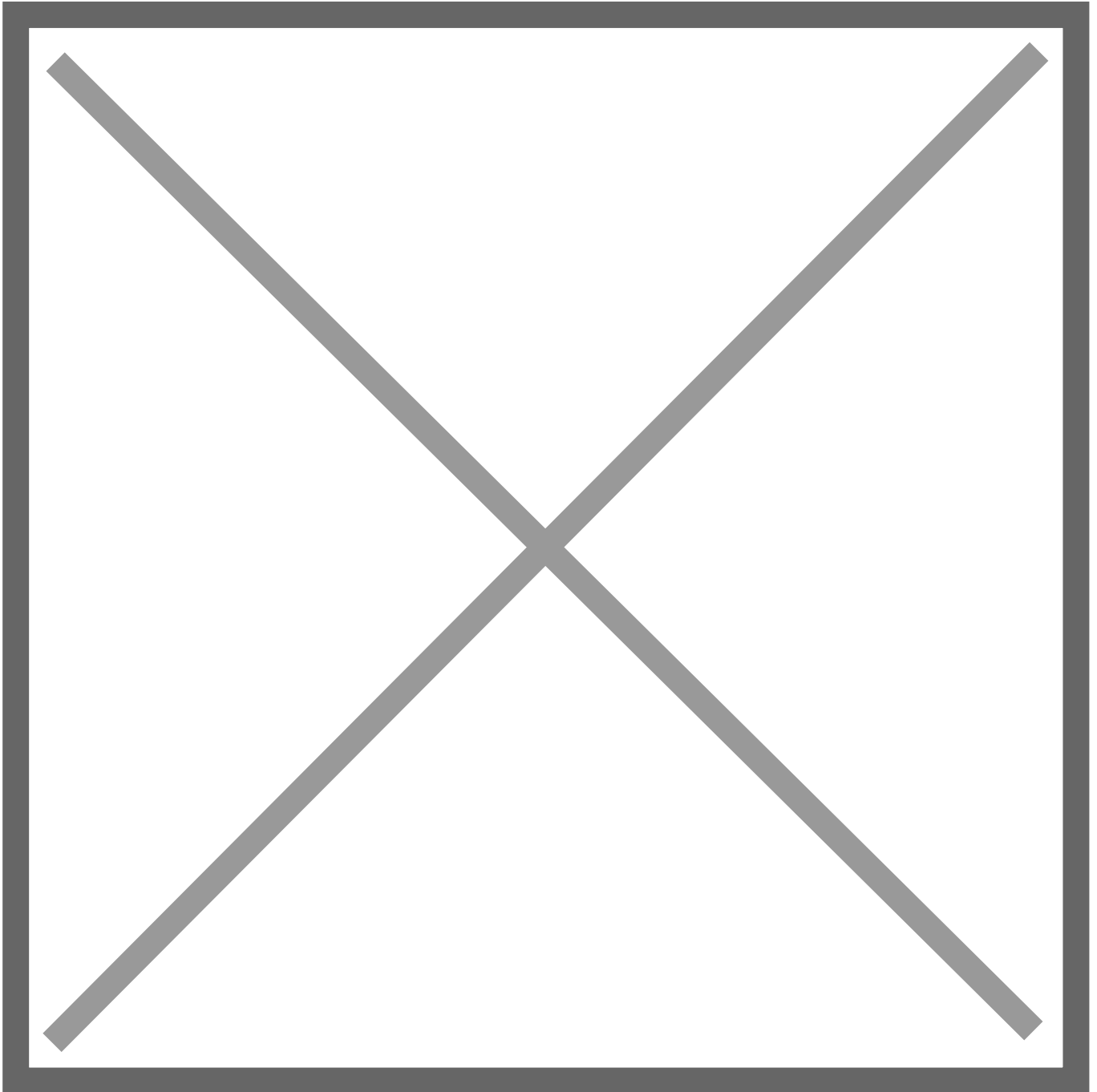


If you wish to export the previously selected publications, choose “**Export**” from the “**Act**” menu.

If you want to export all the results found, choose “**Export All**”. The “Export All” choice is only available from [myUnil](#).



Then choose the **export format** (1) and click on the “**Export**” button (2).



The available formats are:

- **Endnote XML** (to export your list of publications to Endnote)
- **BibTex** (to export your publications to citation management software)
- **ORCID** (to export your list of publications to ORCID).

To import Endnote XML files created in Serval, In Endnote

- Go to the “File” menu and choose “Import”.
- In the “Import Options” list, select “Endnote Generated XML”. Depending on your version of Endnote, you must first click on “Options” to access it.
